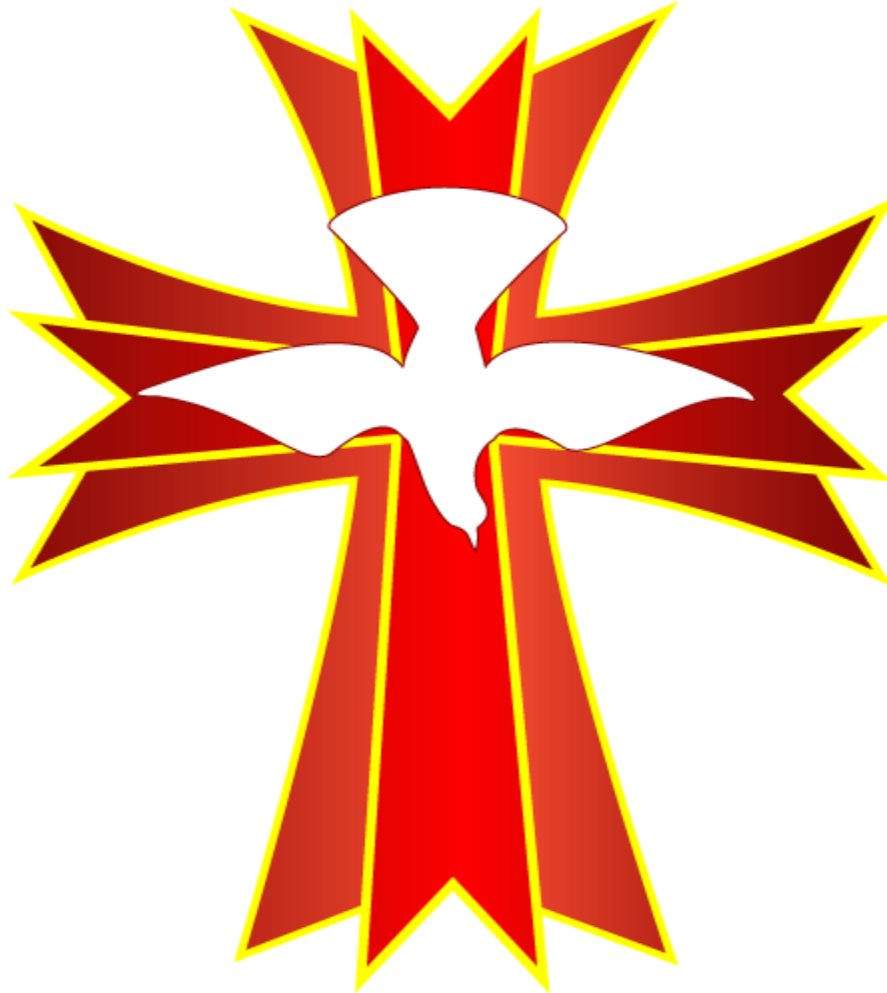

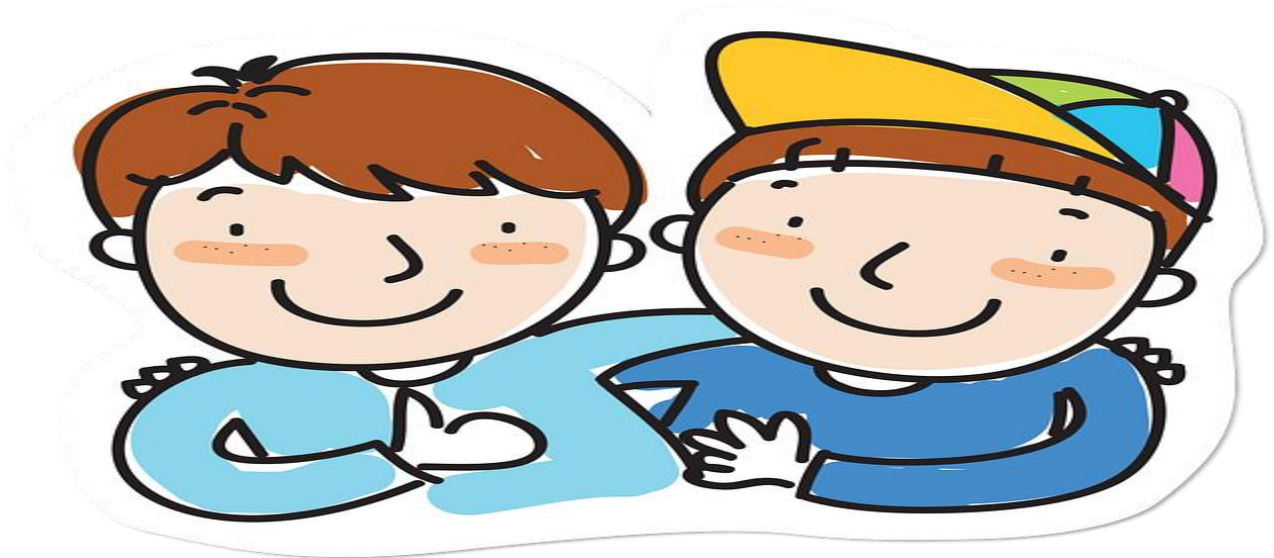

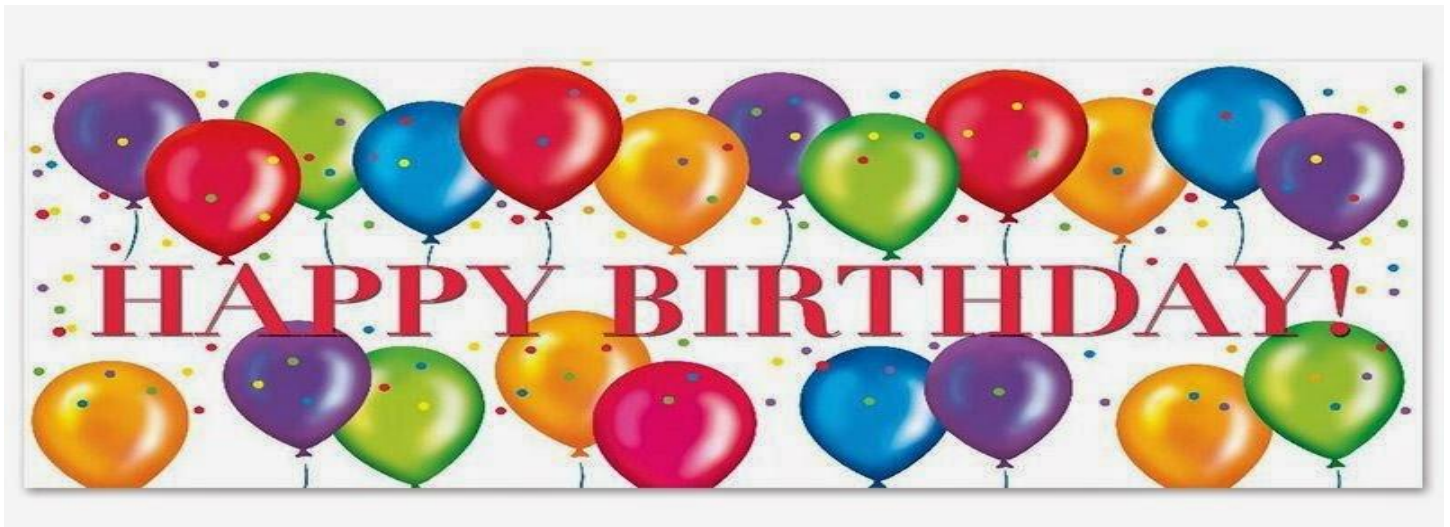
Fellowship Hall Rental
